To be eligible for the *Wisconsin Shares* program parent/guardian(s) must participate in one of the following activities: unsubsidized work (you do not receive any child care benefits through your employer), current attend high school (if under age 20), W-2 employment program, employment skills training and continue being in unsubsidized employment, Food Stamp employment and training work search or work experience programs, are a W-2 applicant participating in up-front job search, training, or orientation activities. Participants must also have a family income level less than 185% of the federal poverty level (FPL).
