### WIC Farmer's Market Nutrition Program

WIC participants may choose to support Wisconsin farmers by using Farmer's Market checks (given by WIC) to purchase Wisconsin grown produce and herbs. WIC approved vendors accept the checks from June 1<sup>st</sup> thru October 31<sup>st</sup>. Ask about these checks at your next WIC appointment.
