How did Trimbelle get its name? Trimbelle was named for the stream, which in the early days was likened to a trim "belle," or lady. The Trimbelle River is a minor tributary of the Mississippi River. It flows for its entire length in western Pierce County, rising in the town of Martell and flowing generally southwardly through the towns of River Falls, Trimbelle, Trenton and Diamond Bluff. It flows into the Mississippi River about 5 miles west of Bay City.
