

Pierce County Recycling **Does Not** accept Gift Wrapping Paper or Fancy Greeting Cards

Gift wrapping paper is not an acceptable recyclable material because it's usually very thin and has little recoverable fiber value. If there is some fiber, it may be deeply dyed color or contain foil with causes paper mills considerable problems.

Some greeting cards can cause the same problem for paper mills, if they contain glitter, foil, metallic inks, photo paper, or adornments (ribbons, beads, velvet, music device); place them in your trash.

Regular cardstock greeting cards with no extras are recyclable.
